THE PROBLEM

Menstrual equity has been a pressing issue in schools, often leading to barriers for students' education and well-being.

Realizing the impact on students' ability to fully engage in their education, he identified menstrual equity as a vital aspect of fostering an inclusive and supportive learning environment.

THE SOLUTION
